

Statement on California Proposition 65

May 2025

Overview

California State's Proposition 65: Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, requires businesses to provide "clear and reasonable" warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. Prop 65 prohibits knowingly discharging or releasing a Prop 65 chemical that may or will enter any California drinking water source.

The State of California maintains a Prop 65 List of chemicals known by the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or reproductive harm. Prop 65 requires businesses to provide "clear and reasonable" warnings if they knowingly and intentionally expose an individual in California to a chemical on the Prop 65 list.

Declaration

NVIDIA's networking products are not intended to expose any person to any chemical on the Prop 65 list during normal product use. Therefore, the Prop 65 "clear and reasonable" warnings requirements do not apply to NVIDIA networking products. As a result, NVIDIA networking products do not include warnings specifically related to Prop 65 or the Prop 65 list of chemicals, and NVIDIA does not make available a specific list of Prop 65 list of chemicals that may be contained in our networking products.

NVIDIA reviews our product content through chemical analysis, suppliers' certifications, and full material content disclosures. NVIDIA and our suppliers may consider certain information to be proprietary and not available for release. NVIDIA also updates material content information as new requirements are identified. Based on this information, NVIDIA has determined that to the best of our knowledge some NVIDIA networking products contain one or more of chemicals on the Prop 65 list. If present, these chemicals are not intended to be exposed to users, nor are they intended to be released or discharged during normal product use.

If after review of available material content and product information we determine an exposure requiring a Prop 65 warning may exist, NVIDIA will provide the necessary "clear and reasonable" warning.
